Who is SORA and COI?

SORA is the only national organization that represents regulators from all 50 states, U.S. territories, tribes and provinces of Canada. SORA's purpose is to facilitate dialogue among regulators and product developers to promote the decentralized wastewater industry's place as a viable and sustainable option for wastewater infrastructure.

Captains of Industry (COI) refers to those companies that offer products and or services for decentralized, including onsite, wastewater treatment. COIs can be non-voting affiliate members of SORA, offering advantageous possibilities to represent their views at SORA meetings.



What is the SORA/COI® ?

SORA/COI® is the annual conference that brings together SORA and COI to network, exchange information, and work toward a sustainable decentralized approach to wastewater. SORA/COI® offers a forum that focuses attention on current wastewater issues and increased opportunities for Captains (manufacturers) to present their products to those capable of permitting its use.

What is the Onsite Wastewater Systems Summit?
